2.	MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING The minutes of the meeting held on 10th January were agreed.	
3.	MATTERS ARISING (i) Further correspondence has been received regarding No Parking signs at The Glebe. It was agreed that the position remains the same and the signs will not be erected until the Gigaclear work is completed in the village. (ii) SOS is disappointed that Gigaclear did not contact the Parish Council regarding disruption to The Green and other areas. MP will write on behalf of the PC requesting a meeting to agree a formal sign off of the clear up process and to discuss issues which will arise as the work in Frampton Mansell progresses. (iii) SOS will look to improve the standing area on the opposite side of the bus stop and PL will address the problem of accumulated mud and debris in the bus shelter. (iv) CH has put in place some of the new salt bins. The remaining three will be positioned once the Gigaclear work is completed. CH will ask GCC to fill up the existing bins.
