2.	MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING The minutes of the meeting held on 12th September 2017 were agreed.	
3.	MATTERS ARISING (a) 17/02938/FUL Planning application at Aston Downs Barns: It was agreed that whilst the Parish Council has no objection in principle to this planning application, the concerns of a number of residents in Frampton Mansell, and beyond, are taken very seriously. SOS will write to the Planning Department acknowledging these concerns and requesting restrictions on the height of any external lighting. The Parish Council is aware some people in the community believe there should have been a more proactive notification of individual residents about this planning application. The Chair reiterated the role of the Parish Council which includes providing an opportunity through monthly meetings for residents to engage in discussion and air their opinions on a range of issues, including planning applications. All current planning applications are included on the agenda and, each month, the agendas for and minutes of meetings are made available on the village notice boards and the website. Individuals are able to sign up to receive notification of planning applications on the CDC website. (b) Chesterton Development in Cirencester: A large number of concerns have been raised in respect of this planning application and the Parish Council will continue to monitor developments.	SOS SOS

It was also agreed that the Parish Council will organise a more in depth First Aid Training Session in the new year, although individuals will need to pay in advance to take part in this event.
