### Minutes of the meeting held on 9th January 2018 Sapperton Village Hall at 7.00pm

<b>1.</b>	<b>APOLOGIES</b> Marcel Puyk	
<b>2.</b>	<b>A419 AND JOLLY NICE CAFÉ JUNCTION</b> CH presented the main concerns of the PC and residents. Councillors Hirst and Parsons agreed that amount and type of traffic has increased during the last few years and Cllr. Hirst will ensure a new survey is carried out as soon as possible. He will also talk with GCC Highways about a revised junction layout. This will also be triggered by the imminent planning application by the owners of Jolly Nice in relation to entrances and exits onto the A419. Cllr Hirst asked the PC to bring to his attention funding requirements in the area for projects which would benefit the community. SOS asked about additional funding for repairs to Sapperton Village Hall. A number of options were discussed. Cllr. Hirst asked for a breakdown of the funding streams and the likely funding gap. SOS will ask the Trustees to provide this.	<b>SOS</b>
<b>3.</b>	<b>PUBLIC FORUM</b> The owner of one of the four properties at Beacon Farm Barns informed the PC of the planning application submitted by another owner to convert the annex of that barn into another dwelling. Objections have been raised by the other owners and the PC will consider the application and make comment.	<b>SOS</b>

CH and KS will contact the suppliers and other sources.</p> <p><b>SD</b> – residents in Sapperton have requested that the mirror is replaced. CH to look for post.</p> <p><b>PL</b> has reported a serious disruption of tarmac outside number 23.</p> <p><b>CH</b> reported the broken railings on the canal bridge and on the opposite side of the road near Bakers Mill to GCC Highways.</p> <p><b>ST</b> – the sign post going towards the crossroads has fallen down again. The Churchyard wall is crumbling. As this is the responsibility of the PCC and CH will investigate. A meeting has been arranged to review work the overhanging/overgrown trees in the Churchyard.
