<b>5.</b>	<b>PLANNING APPLICATIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Beacon Farm Barns - SOS has talked with the Planning Officer and decided that on this occasion, the PC will abstain from comment.</li> <li>- SOS has received a letter regarding The Thatch in Tunley. Residents are concerned about the proposed development and want the planning application to go to the Planning Committee for decision. The PC agreed to support this request.</li> <li>- There were no objections to the Down's Cottage development.</li> </ul>	
<b>6.</b>	<b>A419 AND JUNCTION</b> Cllr Hicks reported that Highways will make some changes to the white lining at the junction, probably in April. There will also be a traffic survey. SOS asked that the concrete block, which is all that remains from the bollards, be removed as a matter of urgency as it is dangerous. The Chair also asked that the weight limit sign be replaced at the junction and a new one erected at the Pike Lane junction, again as a matter of urgency.	
<b>7.</b>	<b>ROAD GRITTING AND FALLEN TREES</b> Cllr. Hicks will ask for a pallet of grit to be delivered and for Amey to liaise with SOS regarding the location of the delivery. Cllr Hicks confirmed that any fallen trees, which were planted more than one metre from the tarmac are the responsibility of the landowner.	.
<b>8.</b>	<b>FINANCE</b> Bank balances: current account £138, savings account £4170 Payments made during January were for grass cutting in FM £945 and the annual donation to each village hall of £250. The Precept has been submitted	
<b>9.</b>	<b>FRAMPTON MANSELL PLAY GROUND</b> The ROSPA notice of inspection has been received for April. It was agreed to fence the full length of the boundary between the Village Hall tarmac area and the grassed area, with one gate for access and to replace the broken fence at the rear
