<b>5.</b>	<b>PLANNING APPLICATIONS</b> There were no planning issues to discuss.	
<b>6.</b>	<b>A419 AND JUNCTION</b> The situation as reported in February 2018 is ongoing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Highways plan to make changes to the white lining at the junction, probably in April.</li> <li>• There will be a traffic survey, date to be confirmed.</li> <li>• The concrete block, which is all that remains from the bollards, is still to be removed as a matter of urgency as it is dangerous.</li> <li>• Although the Chair had requested that the weight limit sign be replaced at the junction and a new one erected at the Pike Lane junction, as a matter of urgency, no action has been taken by Highways.</li> </ul>	
<b>7.</b>	<b>ROAD GRITTING</b> The main lanes within & between Sapperton & Frampton Mansell were cleared by snow plough & gritted; the PC expressed their thanks to Mark Franklin & his team. Grit bins were refilled by Highways in the main village lanes, but not on the side lanes & down by The Hattons. Three new, plastic, grit bins have been supplied & await allocation & fitting (CH to action).	<b>CH</b>
<b>8.</b>	<b>FINANCE</b> Bank balances: Current Account - £55, Savings Account - £3470. The Frampton Mansell Village Hall treasurer thanked the PC for the annual donation of £250.

<b>11.</b>	<b>PARISH COUNCILLOR REPORTS</b> <b>ST</b> confirmed the fallen tree near Ivy Cottage; CH will action the removal. <b>CH</b> – request from a villager in Sapperton to put a rail on the tip by the bus shelter; ongoing. Suggestion made to replace with hedging. <b>MP</b> confirmed that two 'poop bins' to be fitted at The Downs & by The Hattons. Also stated that, despite the road signs, too many lorries were using the villages as a 'SatNav' short cut, causing obstruction, railing & verge damage. <b>SOS</b> stated that arrangements had been made to erect the Sapperton Village Green & Lurcher Lane signs.	<b>CH</b> <b>CH</b> <b>MP</b> <b>SOS</b>
